Description: Come join us for a fun filled celebration of bugs! At the end of the five-week program you and your child will gain a new respect for snails, ants, spiders, bees and butterflies. A field trip to the Palo Alto Junior Museum and Zoo will be planned. The class will consist of a maximum of 25 children per session per day, ages 3 through 5 years old. All children need to be potty trained and able to sit at circle time with minimal assistance. ***Please send your child with a packed snack each day (NO NUTS OR PEANUT BUTTER!!!).***

Parents Duties: We are a Co-op, or Parent Participation nursery school. As parents we work together along with the teachers to run the program. Your duties include:

- Working at the school as a teacher aide one regularly scheduled day per week (examples of a parent work day job are: Outdoor Person, Art Person, Varied Project).
- Having at least one scheduled EPOD (Emergency Parent Of the Day) day during the five week session (a second EPOD day may be required)
- Completing one job/task (examples of these are: cut out pieces for an art project, or purchase two bottles of starch).
- Attendance at the **mandatory orientation meeting. Date and time to be announced.**
- Help with general clean up of the school at the end of the session
